Wayne Fire Ordinance

1. Department created.
There is hereby created a Fire Department for the Town of Wayne, which shall consist of the Fire Chief and such other members as may be provided by the Board of Selectmen.
2. Appointments.
The Fire Chief shall be appointed for a term not to exceed three years by the Board of Selectmen. All other appointments to, or promotions within, the department shall be made by the Fire Chief.
3. Compensation.
The compensation of all members of the Department shall be set by vote of the Town at its Town Meeting.
4. Duties of Chief.
The Fire Chief shall be responsible to the Selectmen for the performance by the Department of its functions.
5. Chapter 228 of Title 30 of the Maine Revised Statutes is incorporated herein insofar as it applies and does not conflict with any other provisions of this ordinance.
